Please note: All vendors, including winter/summer-only vendors, must be current members of Bennington Farmers' Market. Annual membership dues of \$25 run November through October. All members receive a vote at the Annual Membership Meeting in the Fall.

Stall Fees for a 12 foot space. Stall fees are \$15 per market day (paid at the beginning of every month) or paid in advance for the full season. Paying in advance for the season entitles you to a 10 percent discount. Full season payments are due by the first winter market.
